NEW MANAGER OF BANK MONTREAL **NOVA SCOTIAN**

Mr. Lawson Numbers Among His Antecedents Two Bank Presidents — Has Had a Successful Career.

Mr. G. Lawson, who has been appointed manager of the Fredericton Branch of the Bank of Montreal to succeed the late Mr. G. N. C. Hawkins, comes of an old Nova Scotia family, and is a native of Windsor, N. S. It is interesting to note that his paternal great-grandfather, William Lawson, was the first president of the Bank of Nova Scotia, while his maternal great-grandfather, John Gray, was the first president of the Bank of

Mr. Lawson entered the service of the Bank of Montreal in Halifax in 1902. He rose steadily in the ranks, and has acted as accountant in the branches at Amherst, Moncton, St. Roch, Saint John, N. B., and Quebec. In 1919 he was appointed assistant manager in Quebec, and in 1920 he was transferred to the Yarmouth office as manager, holding that position until the date of his present appoint-

In Yarmouth Mr. Lawson took an active part in the business and social life of the community. He was for two years President of the Board of Trade, and he was Treasurer of the Nova Scotia Sea Fisheries Association and the local Golf and Country Club. He is a member of the United Church of Canada.

BAKED BEAN CLUB SANDWICH

(By Request)

- 1 can baked beans
- 1 pickle
- 2 firm tomatoes
- 1-2 cup mayonnaise or dressing of choice

Sredded lettuce

Crush the baked beans with the back of spoon; do not mash them. Spread the bread rather thick with the beans; cover each slice with shredded lettuce which has been patted dry between cheesecloth or paper toweling. Skin the tomatoes and put a slice between the spread bread; spread the tomato with mayonnaise, or dressing of choice, and put a thin slice of pickle between or on the side of the sandwich. Crust bread before making he sandwich.




