

GREAT FORTUNES PILED UP BY CANADIAN TRADERS IN NICKEL AND BRAZILIAN STOCKS

(Journal of Commerce.)

The credit for the tremendous advance in International Nickel and the relative appreciation in Brazilian Traction shares is largely attributed to J. W. McConnell and P. P. Cowans, the Montreal financiers. It is indeed a fact, that in the case of both companies the initial market movements coincided with the advent of Mr. McConnell on the respective boards of directors.

Mr. McConnell is known to have been exceedingly well disposed towards much higher prices in both instances for the past two years, and as a result of his confidence and foresight, he now enjoys, according to his intimate friends, "paper profits," or market increment, on his holdings of these two securities alone, aggregating between ten and fifteen million dollars. In fact, these friends go so far as to assert that this general investment increment has exceeded \$20,000,000 in the past five years, and it is well known that he made an unusual "killing" in Montreal Power shares which he began to accumulate five or six years ago.

A Co-operative Influence.

As a co-operative influence in the market advance of International Nickel and Brazilian Traction, based upon an appreciation of ultimate earning values in both cases, P. P. Cowans of McDougall and Cowans has been a supreme factor, in conjunction with his tremendous following throughout the Dominion.

Mr. Cowans, in the instance of International Nickel, has, in fact, beaten Wall Street to its knees, notwithstanding an almost nation-wide drive at Nickel on the American markets during the past few months.

It has been a superb operation, requiring infinite courage and confidence in the basic conditions, and its

justification is to be found in the results obtained to date.

Smugly Confident.

Wall Street has been smugly confident of its ability to smother this small group of Canadian leaders, who have had the audacity to assume market control of a stock that has been listed on the New York Stock Exchange for many years. In this connection, it was not until the stock of this American-owned Canadian corporation was put on the Canadian markets that it was removed from the category of a market football, kicking around in the neighborhood of \$15 to \$30 a share.

As one of the Wall Street "paragraphs" recently said to the American shorts in Nickel: "The Canadians will get you, if you don't watch out!" and the Canadians certainly did all that, with a vengeance.

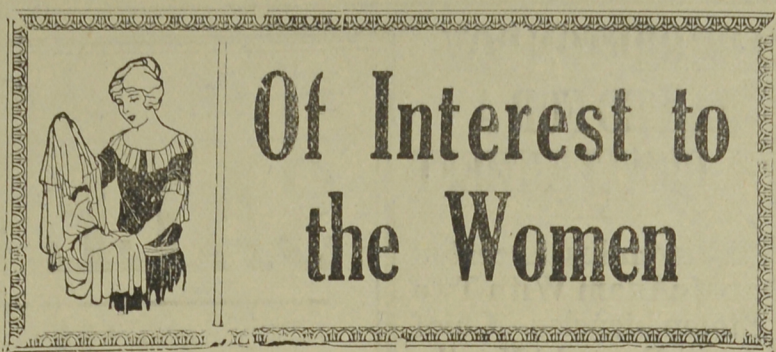

Of Interest to the Women

WHITE HOUSE POTATOES

To one quart well seasoned mashed potatoes add two egg yolks (or one whole egg) slightly beaten and two canned pimientos, finely chopped. (Use the small three and one half ounces can.) Pile lightly in a casserole or glass baking dish. Place in a hot oven to reheat for about ten minutes.

DATE PUDDING

1-2 cup flour
1-8 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon baking powder
2 cups (one package) dates, sliced
1 cup chopped walnuts
2 egg yolks
1-2 cup sugar
2 egg whites
Sift flour, salt and baking powder into a mixing bowl. Mix dates and coarsely chopped nuts through the flour with the finger tips. Beat egg yolks, beat in the sugar gradually. Stir in the flour, dates and nut mixture. Fold in the stiffly beaten egg whites. Bake in a well oiled bread pan in a slow oven (275 degrees Fahrenheit) for one to one and a quarter hours. Remove from the pan, cool, cut in slices and serve as cake or with whipped cream as a dessert.

GRAPEFRUIT AND STUFFED CELERY SALAD.

1 can grapefruit
6 stalks celery
2 to three ounces snappy package cheese
French salad dressing
Lettuce or other salad green
Stuff the celery stalks with the cheese; slice into half inch sections place in the center of salad plate and surround with grapefruit sections. Serve with French dressing or mayonnaise.

ORANGE CREAM FILLING

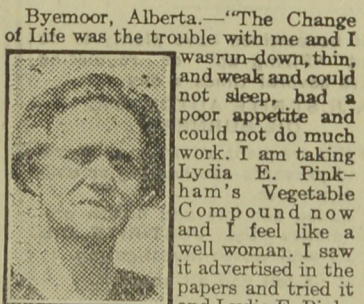
1-2 cup sugar
2 tablespoons flour
1-4 cup orange juice
1 teaspoon lemon juice
1 teaspoon butter
1 egg
Mix the sugar and flour and salt. Add the orange juice and a small amount of orange rind. Then add the softened butter and the egg yolk. Put in the upper part of a double boiler and cook stirring constantly until thick. Cool and put between the layers of the orange cake.

And lastly in this discussion of left over egg yolks, I suggest that if you have nothing better to do with the yolks add them to whole eggs and make a dish of scrambled eggs. Serve them with a garnish of crisp bacon and a generous serving of new potatoes in butter and parsley and you have a luncheon dish fit for any one, king, queen or family.

BAKED TOMATOES STUFFED WITH MINCED DUCK

Remove thin slices from the stem ends of smooth, medium sized tomatoes. Take out the pulp and add equal quantities of rice and minced duck season with salt, pepper and a few drops of onion juice and refill the tomatoes with the mixture. Place in a buttered pan, sprinkle with buttered crumbs and bake twenty minutes in a hot oven (450 degrees Fahrenheit.)

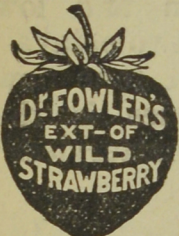

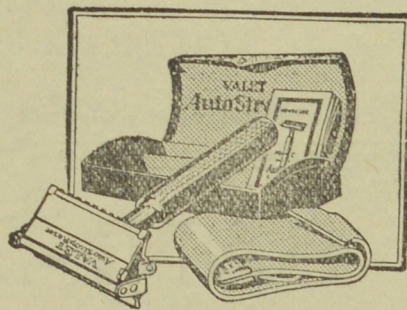
