Of Interest to the Women

MINT APPETIZER

2 level tablespoons chopped mint leaves
3 tablespoons sugar syrup
2 tablespoons lemon juice
1 tablespoon orange juice
Green color paste
1-2 cup charged water
Put the mint leaves with the sugar and syrup and let stand 1-2 hour or longer. Add the fruit juice and color paste to make a delicate green. Dilute with charged water and mix thoroughly. Put crushed ice in four cocktail glasses, pour in the mixture and serve at once.

PLUM APPETIZER

1 quart plums
1 1-2 cups water
1-2 cup sugar
Few grains salt
1-8 teaspoon cinnamon
1 orange
Wash the plums, put into saucepan with the cold water and boil slowly 5 minutes or until tender. Mash and add the sugar and boil 5 minutes longer; pour into strainer (do not mash the pulp through). When the juice is cold, serve over crushed or shaved ice, sprinkle with cinnamon and garnish with a slice of orange.

PEACH COCKTAIL

1-4 cup peach syrup
1 tablespoon lemon juice
3 tablespoons orange juice
1-2 cup ginger ale
Crushed ice
Mix the peach syrup with the orange and lemon juice and ginger ale; and pour over the mixture; serve at once.

AN EASILY PREPARED APPETIZER

Spiced cucumber rings, watermelon rind or canteloupe served on cracker or toast and garnished with pimento makes a very good appetizer when served ice cold.

WATERMELON COCKTAIL

Cut good ripe watermelon into one half inch cubes or with French cutter into balls; place in ice cream glasses or sherbet cups and then pour over one tablespoonful of orange juice. Serve cold.

GRAPE JUICE COCKTAIL

1-2 cup purple grape juice
2 tablespoons white grape juice
1 tablespoon sugar syrup
1 tablespoon lemon juice
1-2 cup effervescent water
Brushed ice

LEMON APPETIZER

1 cup lemon juice
1 tablespoon grated lemon rind
1 cup sugar
1 1-2 cups water
Boil sugar and water together ten minutes. Remove from fire. When cold, add the strained lemon juice and grated rind; serve over shaved ice and garnish with candied cranberries and very thin slices of lemon places on edge of glass or a sprig of fresh mint.

DEVILED EGG APPETIZER

1 hard boiled egg
1 teaspoonful finely chopped parsley
Salt and pepper to taste
1 tablespoon mayonnaise or salad dressing of choice
2 drops of onion juice
5 small pieces of toasted bread
Rub the egg through coarse strainer, add seasoning, flavoring, dressing and 1 teaspoon of parsley; mix well and spread on toasted bread. Cut in finger shapes. Sprinkle with parsley and paprika.

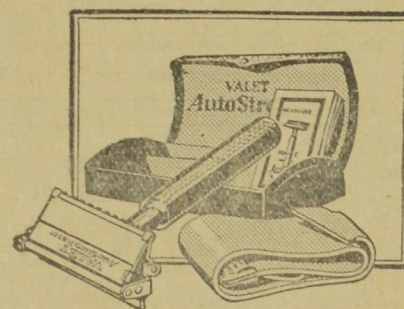
