ise a Dover beater. When light, add half a cupful of chopped pecans or English walnuts and a teaspoonful of maple flavoring. Stand on the ice and use when the cake is cold. This filling changes the whole tone of a plain or a sponge cake.

PINEAPPLE FILLING

1 cupful of crushed or grated pingapple

1-2 lemon

Powdered sugar

Drain the pineapple, add the lemon and beat in enough powdered sugar to make it the right thickness to spread. This can be used also for the icing.

ICINGS

All these icings are made precisely the same, simply change the flavoring. Put a cupful of powdered sugar in a bowl, add the flavoring and about two tablespoonfuls of hot water, a little at a time. When the mixture is smooth and thick enough to spread easily, use it. For orange and lemon icing, use the fruit juice in the place of water, add at the last just a little of the grated yellow rind
