S., Jan. 12-Armed with the authority furnished him by the decision of the judicial committee of the Privy Council, Premier Rhodes has taken the first steps toward final abolition of the legislative council of Nova Scotia. In a letter sent yesterday to life members of the council, Premier Rhodes requests them to send him their resignations, reminding them of the decision of the Privy Council authorizing the government to appoint additional members sufficient to give a majority to an abolition bill. and also referring to their pledges, given at the time of appointment, to support an abolition bill.
