ISSUES REPORT ON THE LUMBER INDUSTRY

The lumber industry in Canada is at present undergoing an interesting change. The centre of production is moving from Eastern Canada to the Pacific slope and in the East much of the material cut in the woods is being diverted from the saw-mill to the pulp and paper mill. Generally speaking there is a tendency toward a reduction in the output of lumber in eastern Canada due partly to diminishing supplies and partly to the demands of the pulp and paper industry. In the province of British Columbia on the other hand the cut of lumber is increasing and the product is invading the eastern market via the Panama Canal. The white pine of the East and some of the eastern hardwoods will always be preferred for certain industrial purposes as long as they are obtainable. The large clear sizes in which British Columbia lumber can be obtained is one of the chief reasons for its present popularity.

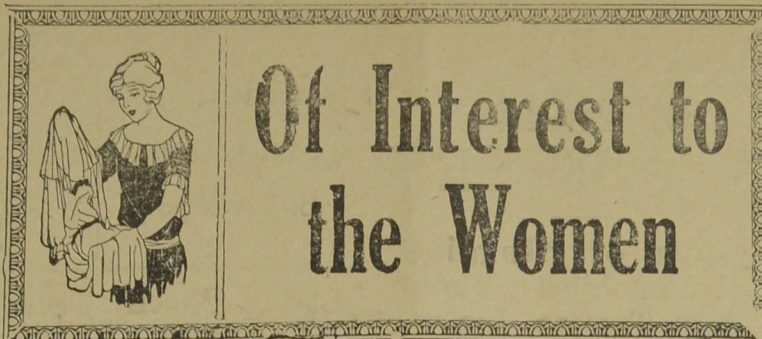
Apart from regional differences in species and sizes of trees, wood will always be one of the most generally useful of all the raw materials used in industry. The supply is rapidly diminishing in certain regions, but it is highly improbable in this enlightened age that it will ever be completely exhausted. We will no doubt pass through a period of lean years before we begin to reap the benefit of present and future applications of scientific forestry methods. The area of land in Canada which is economically suited for forest production is very large and once this area is placed on a sustained yield basis we will be assured of a permanent annual supply of timber of all kinds sufficient for the needs of industry in Canada with a satisfactory surplus over for exportation.
