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

"I knew something of Port Said ten years ago and a little more of Shanghai still more recently.

"Thinking over this question of criminal centers, I came to one defnite conclusion, and that is that the vicious spirit has never really impregnated a place which has not been first whitewashed with the eneer of a spurious civilization."
