isdiction can be invaded by Congress "The decision has no constitutional or legal effect, nor any parallel, in Canada", said Mr. Reid, "because under the British North America Act the Dominion Government has full jurisdiction to invade the legislative area and powers of the Provinces un der various conditions, which the Privy Council has laid down in a long line of decisions over a period of seventy years, or since the B. N. A. Act was passed in 1867.


