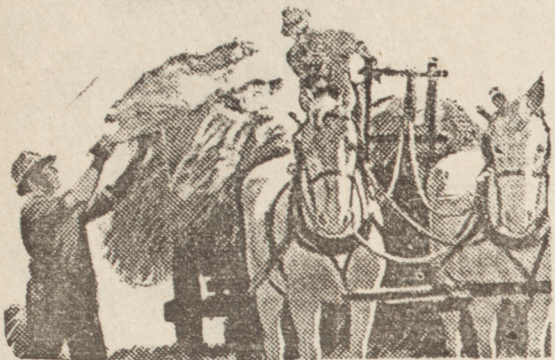


# The Finest Display of Agricultural Products In the Maritime Provinces Is the Opinion Of Experts

We are spending more money this year for amusements and believe we have a well balanced and most attractive program. We have selected the best acts offered, all entirely new to the east and one of the executives of a large Circus, in looking over our program asked who selected the acts, and pointing to them one after the other remarked, "I must congratulate you on having selected the very finest acts it is possible for you to secure, and I wonder how you are able to book some of them as they are in demand wherever acts are booked." Robert Ripley of 'Believe It Or Not' fame carried the act billed as 'Tip-Top Girls' for 15 weeks in his 'Believe It Or Not' Show. The Tip-Top Girls will make their first appearance in the east on our all-star amusement program. They will please and astound you.

A rare act for children from six to sixty is Cresman's Aristocratic Goats six pure chargers whose hoofs and horns are tinted with a rich gold. They construct pyramids, roll on barrels, walk the tight wire and execute

pretty statuary numbers. This act also presents a program of entertainment from the Western Plains including whips, trick roping and comedy sharpshooting. They are clever, well recommended and something new and will be well worth seeing when they make their first appearance here.

A news dispatch received from Osaka, Japan says, "Five Albanis aerial motorcycle sensation are a decided hit at Osaka Japanese Exhibition. The Albanis are returning at the end of this engagement to play Parks and Fairs in America." An athletic act that can please the Japanese must be good because Japan is famous for its athletes. It is a long jump from Japan to Fredericton but we believe in buying the best, and the first appearance in the east of the Five Albanis will be on our all-star amusement program.

An act that played two command performances before the King and Queen of England must be worth seeing. The Five Elgins, known professionally as Their Juggling Magesties are proud holders of this distinction and have returned to America to entertain and astonish their audiences. They are internationally renowned and are declared to be 'tops' in comedy as well as in art. They are highly sought after because of their eminence and our patrons will be pleased to know that the Five Elgins will appear at our coming exhibition.

The White Brothers are sometimes called the Ti-Top Boys, and this is a very apt title for their act is 'tops' in this line. They present a keen acrobatic comedy showing great skill and a finished performance that provides pleasure side-splitting laughter and sensational acrobatics and contortions that may only be done through long training. Their comedy mule is a combination that appeals to both old and young and the whole act is an outstanding sensation. We have been after this act for several years and have at last obtained it for the big program of amusements this year.

An amusement program without a clown is like a circus without an elephant. The amusement program at Fredericton Exhibition is well balanced and the clowns Will Morris and Bobby are world celebrated. They perform on and off bicycles doing a real act as well as clowning and are in the front rank of a branch of comedy entertainment that will live in the minds of those who see them long after the performance is past. They claim that they were placed on earth

to make people laugh and they are successful 100%.

Amusements at an exhibition must take a leading place, but we try to balance our program so that the amusement add to rather than take from the educational features. For 1937 we offer a program of expansion in all departments, more money for live stock, finer exhibits in fruit, flowers and agriculture and better facilities and comforts for our patrons.

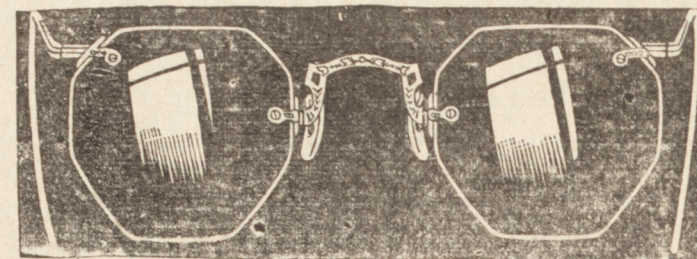

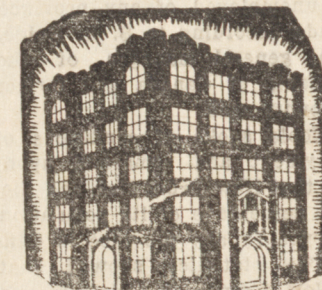
