They found that the solution of area got rid of mucus, crusts and dead tissue, and that the urea seemed to have a good effect by stopping the growth of germs, acting as an antiseptic. ### Harmless and Cheap

There are a number of things about the urea which makes it a useful drug. It is harmless and nonpoisonous. For example, it can be put in water and the solution kept for any length of time. The solution will not burn or irritate the surrounding skin, when it is used for treating a wound. It also seems to get rid of the bad odor from infected wounds.

In order to do its work properly, a strong solution of the urea must be used. One of the patients treated had a carbuncle. He had a temperature of 103 degrees, as a result of the infection. The carbuncle was opened and the wound was packed with the powdered user, that is, the crystalline form without any water. The next day, the temperature had dropped to 991/2 degrees; the patient was quite comfortable. The third day, the temperature was normal and remained so until the wound healed completely.


