Everyone, however, should know and remember the four cardinal First Aid rules, in order to be prepared for emergencies.

They are: first, send for a doctor; second, keep calm; third, keep the crowd away from the patient; and fourth, keep the pattern quiet.

The preesnce of mind to follow these rules, Dr. Fraser points out, is frequently all that is necessary when an accident occurs.
