Some owners fail to realize the importance of giving generous treatment to colts, especially during the first year of their lives. Too many colts are kept in small, dark, poorly ercise is provided and many are serlously undernourished. This method of rearing colts is resulting in the development of undersized horses possessing legs and feet lacking quality, due largely to neglect.

Colts should not be overfed but they should secure an abundance of good clean clover or mixed hay, plus pounds fed daily will prove a good in-
