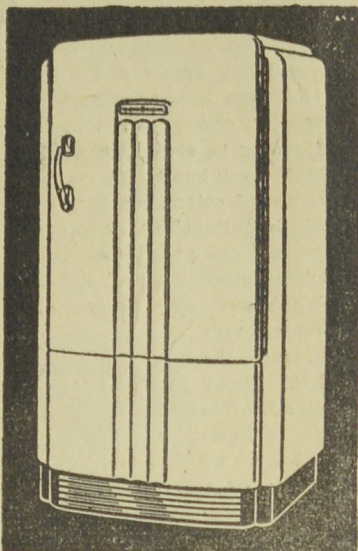

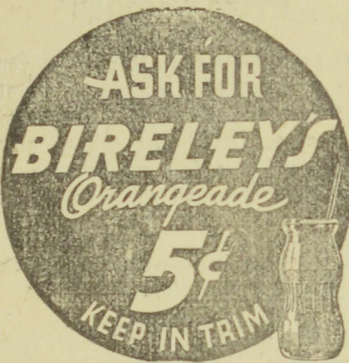

close.

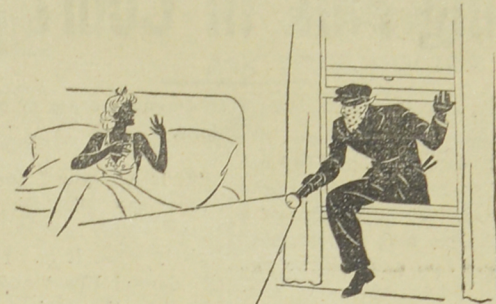

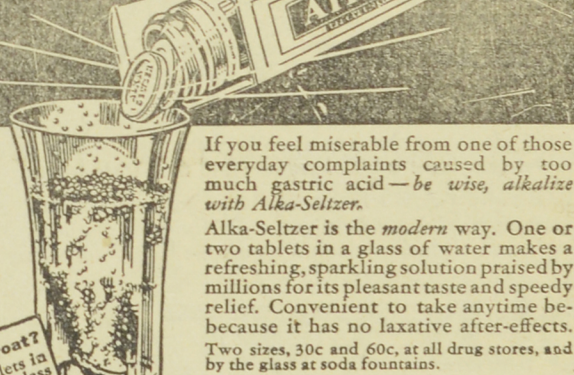
