INDIANS DON'T WANT MANHATTAN GIVEN BACK

NEW YORK, May, 15—The Indians
have had their chance to take Man-
hattan Island back and they don't
want it.

"No!" they shouted. "No want
him!"
The offer was made symbolically
as part of the Manhattan Week
celebration at the World's Fair.
Soix, Ponca, and Ojibwa tribesmen
from the fair's amusement section—
none of them descendants of the In-
dians who sold the island to the whit-
men for \$24 in 1626—took part in a
pageant intended to show the historic
sale and magnanimous World of To-
morrow offer to return the island.
"now worth \$24,000,000,000."

They had been intended to make
speeches praising the white fathers'
development of the island and point-
ing out that they were perfectly sat-
isfied with the present owners. In-
stead they lapsed into Indian gut-
tural, shouted "No, No," and seemed
horrified.

Chief Sugar Brown of the Ojibwa,
heading the delegation, was asked,
"What would you do with New York
if they really turned it over to you?"
"I'll give it back to the Indians,"
he said.


rial sympathy who can see and feel

of the rank and file of our people
must be quickened into new life and

In concluding his sermon, Rev. Mr.
Atkinson pointed out that our great-
est incentives are lent us by Christ.
Human life will never be a second-
ary consideration nor degraded by
selfish misuse of privilege. For us the
mind of Christ is God's wisdom about
life. Let this mind be in you which
was also in him, who, though highly
empowered, held all humbly, dedicat-
ed it unselfishly and even sacrificial-
ly renounced it and left us the nob-
lest thing in human history, the ap-
peal of his vicarious life.
