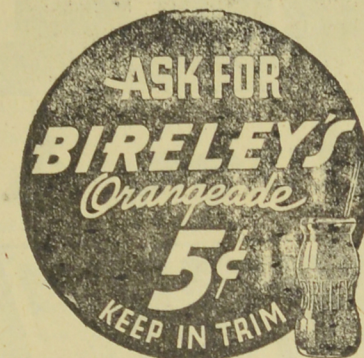

WINNING CONTRACT

By the Four Aces

(David Bruce Burnstone, Merwin D. Maier, Oswald Jacoby, Howard Schenken, world's leading team of four, inventors of the system that has beaten every other system in existence.)

BLUFFED

South, Dealer

East-West vulnerable

The bidding:

South West North East
1♠ 1NT Dbl. Pass
2♣ Dbl. 3♠ Pass
Pass Pass

West opened the Ace of spades and followed with a small spade. Declarer won with the King in dummy, went over to his own hand with a low spade and led a heart. West ducked and dummy won the trick with the Queen. A low heart was now played and West's Ace dropped. Now West led a diamond. Declarer went up with the Ace in dummy, led the King of hearts, discarding a low diamond from his own hand, trumped a heart, thereby establishing the last heart in dummy and conceded two club tricks, making his three-spade contract.

On almost any opening but the Ace and another spade the hand would have been beaten, and East started to bawl out his partner. That was too much for West, who said, "Do you realize we could have made at least four notrump with this hand? Didn't it ever occur to you with all your Queens and Jacks that you could make some bid?"

East replied, "I thought you were fooling," whereupon West, a fine player, now pointed out, "We were vulnerable; they weren't. If you think I am going to fool around under those circumstances, you're crazy!" Yesterday you were Howard Schenken's partner and held:

In This District

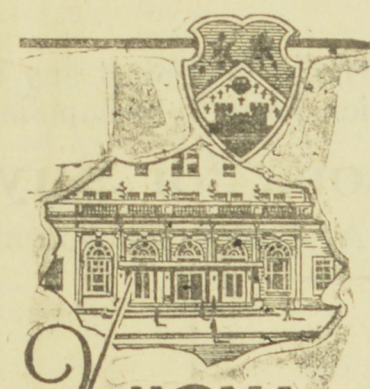
Last night's heavy rain cleared the main streets of the city of the late snow, and aided considerably in weakening the ice still holding fast at Fredericton.

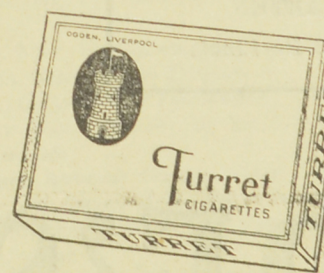
