N. Y. WRITER SUGGESTS N. B. BEAR HUNTING

Raymond Camp in the Rod and Gun column of the New York Daily Times recently published the following:
A letter from Alex Price, our old Miramichi guide, says the bear will be out in time to welcome the early salmon and trout anglers up in New Brunswick.

"They will be combing the beach ridges as soon as the snow leaves the slopes," he writes, "and you can alternate taking salmon and trout with bear-hunting. I'm planning to open my camps here and on the Cains River by April 15, and from all indications this is going to be a grand season. The ice hasn't broken up as yet, but when it does things should be perfect, as there was an unusually large run of fish in the Miramichi last fall."

If you plan on going up there this Spring, pick up one of the free bear-hunting licenses that the Province offers to all anglers.

CABINET MEETING

The first meeting of the New Brunswick cabinet since prorogation of the Legislature last week is expected to be held this afternoon. Premier A. A. Dymally arrived late last night from his home at Buctouche, Hon. E. J. Henneberry, President of the Executive Council arrived from Saint John this morning, and other cabinet ministers are expected in time for the meeting.

Although no delegations have applied for a hearing, it is understood a delegation from the Town Council of Devon will appear before the government to seek permission to grant license for establishment of a creamery in Devon. Other routine matters will receive the attention of the cabinet.

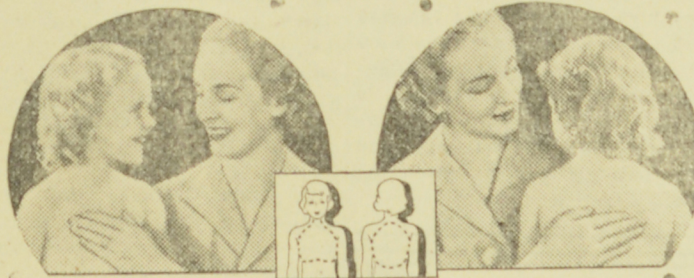
