HALLOWE'EN SPOOK PARTY

DISPELS GHOST OF GLOOM

Home Merrymaking Provides More Fun Than Traditional Destructive Outdoor Pranks

Why don't you make a spook party this year and take the mind of your mischievous small boy and his tomboy sister off destructive Hallowe'en pranks by giving the pair of them more fun than they've ever had in their lives?

At a spook party, not only the decorations, but the guests and food take on a slightly fantastic air. The sandwiches are done as weird animals or weirder human faces just by using a set of sandwich cutters or else your own ingenuity and an ordinary knife or pair of scissors.

Popcorn scarecrows, made of three popcorn balls with raisins or nuts for eyes, nose and mouth; sticks of candy for arms and blobs of popcorn for hands will tickle the younger children.

Special Plates

Hallowe'en paper table cloths have witches, cats, owls and broomsticks scattered over them and napkins to match. You can even get paper cocktail napkins done in the Hallowe'en manner. Also paper-china, if that's the name for it, made of a composition paper.

Enormous pirates and pumpkin men made of shirred crepe paper are perfect for table centre pieces. One pumpkin man in orange and red is three feet high and stuffed. A swash-buckling pirate with a gold dagger,

wide orange breeches and a snarl on on his wicked face, stands against a treasure trunk which is filled with favors.

Favors this year are more useful than usual—ash trays with green skeleton heads attached which may hold candy at the table; a black spider that supports a practical napkin ring, a candle holder of a hollowed composition pumpkin.

Party Sandwiches

The sandwiches for the children's party, like those for the party for grown-ups, may be cut in fancy shapes. If desired, they may be cut in circles, with goblins' faces cut out on half the slices. When the sandwiches are put together—with one of the fancy slices on top, the eyes, nose and mouth will stand out. White bread, brown bread, or a slice each of white and brown may be used to make the party sandwich. Children usually enjoy sandwiches made of nut, date or orange bread.

Black Cat Favors

Use large, pump prunes for the body. Lay these on candied orange slices with a curved licorice stick stuck into the end of the prune to form the tail. The head is made of half a prune attached to the body with a toothpick. Their whiskers are whisk broom straws and the features are painted on with icing.

are used, dates, figs and raisins. A fat brown gnome can be made of a plump fig by adding to it raisin hands and feet, a pink gumdrop face and a shaved raisin hat.
