- 1 cup milk.
- 11/2 cup sugar 2 teaspoons cream tartar.
- 1 cup soda.
- 1 teaspoon salt sifted with flour. 1 teaspoon vanilla.
- 1/2 teaspoon ginger or nutmeg.

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 cup white sugar
