### NATIONALIST ALLIES AGAINST A NAVY

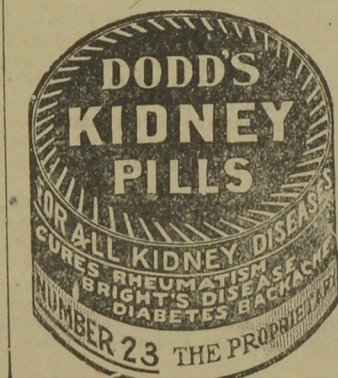

Seven Nationalists voted against making a contribution of \$35,000,000 for three Dreadnoughts to be handed over to the British Admiralty. Twelve Nationalist-Conservatives, who eighteen months ago spoke vehemently against a contribution, voted for it. But all the Nationalists and Nationalist-Conservatives voted against Laurier's proposal to build and maintain Canadian squadrons on the Atlantic and Pacific coasts.

Seven against, and twelve for the Borden contribution. The whole nineteen against a Canadian naval defence force. Why? Here is the explanation put plainly by L'Evenement, Postmaster-General Pelletier's organ, and the chief French Conservative paper of the Quebec district:—

"It is only a gift of money. You will never bear any more of it. There is no danger. The British will hire men at 25 cents a day, and Canadian mothers and sisters will suffer no loss. As for the money, Ontario will pay for it, and the West will pay for it. It will not take your sons from your homes, as the infernal Laurier would do."

The "infernal" Laurier is still held up by Mr. Borden's followers from Quebec as the man who, in defence of Canada, would take the habitants' sons from their homes.



### MARITIME BANKS ARE NOW MERGED

The Bank of New Brunswick is now an institution of the past as far as the public is concerned at least. At the close of business on Saturday the bank became an integral part of the Bank of Nova Scotia.

Both these institutions were about the same age, dating back to the early part of last century, and it is certain that the latter will carry on all the good traditions established by the former.

Through this merger the Bank of Nova Scotia has secured nineteen new branches most of which are located in the Maritime Provinces.

Wherever the Nova Scotia and the New Brunswick banks overlapped, the New Brunswick branch has been closed. But this does not mean that the Nova Scotia has that much less competition.

In almost every such instance other banks have entered the field, and these with their wider diffusion of branches will be able to give the people of the localities affected an even better banking service than they have had in the past.

All this talk we hear nowadays about encouraging agriculture and helping the farmer is enough to give one a pain. The only help a New Brunswick farmer needs today is a market for his produce, and a square deal from what are known as the "big interests." A good farmer with a good farm should be the most independent man in the country.

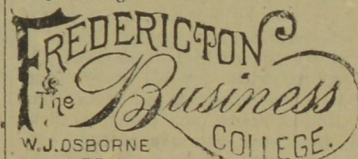
