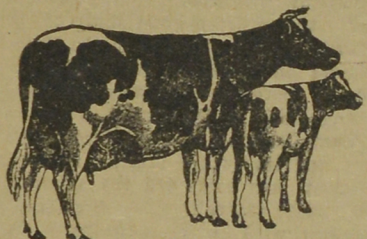

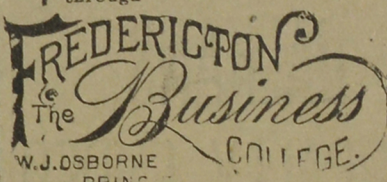

PRICES WOULD RISE
SAYS PRODUCE MEN

Montreal, Jan. 22—Free markets in the United States for meats and for Canadian foodstuffs, the necessity for which, from the United States standpoint, is shown before the Ways and Means Committee in Washington, would mean higher prices in Canada for butter, cheese and meats—that is the common opinion expressed by Mr. A. Hodgson and Mr. John McKergow, both of whom are experts in the produce trade of Canada.

"Free entry of Canada's produce into the United States would mean famine prices in Canada." That is the frankly expressed opinion of Mr. Hodgson, who discussed the question with a Star representative today.

"Free entry of foodstuffs and meat into the United States would mean enhanced prices in Canada." That was the more guarded opinion of Mr. John McKergow, of the firm of A. A. Jager & Co.

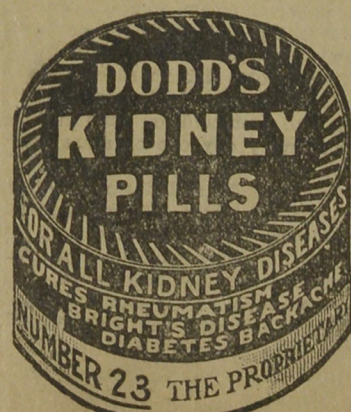

SHE MADE FIRST TEXAS FLAG

Ft. Valley, Ga., Jan. 22—The girl who made the first Texas flag, when that state was an independent republic, lies buried in a neglected grave near here. Arrangements have been made by a commissioner sent by Governor Colquitt of Texas for the removal of the remains to Austin, where they will be received with all honor.

Miss Joanna Troutman, in 1836, then a girl of eighteen, fashioned the Lone Star flag which is still the state emblem of Texas. The present session of the Texas legislature is expected to appropriate funds for the removal of the body and erection of a monument over the grave in the State Cemetery at Austin, where rest the remains of many famous Texans.

The City of Fredericton will present at the approaching Session of the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick the following bills for enactment:

(1) A Bill authorizing the City to grant certain concessions to the Palmer-McLellan Company, Limited, and to fix the valuation of the property of Frasers Limited in this City for taxation purposes.

(2) A Bill to authorize the issue of Debentures for the erection of a Fire Station, a Police Station, for the purchase of Queen's Park and for the further construction of Permanent Street Pavements, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000).

(3) A Bill to provide for lighting by electricity the Fredericton and St. Mary's Highway Bridge.
