

The case of Henry J. Klotz, who was arrested a few days ago upon the charge of having killed a woman known in the Tenderloin district as Helen Taylor, by means of a bomb which he sent to her apartment on February 3, 1912, presents an interesting phychological problem. sleep. eems to be another case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde. Klotz is a draughtsman and for seventeen years he has held a position in the Topographical Bureau of the city, enjoying the absolute confidence of his superiors and friends. He was a skillful worker and faithful in attending to his duties. An investigation by the detectives is said to have es tablished the fact that this side of Klotz's nature formed a strong contrast with the individuality he pre-Charles C. 




