



NOTICE OF LEGISLATION

The City of Fredericton will present at the approaching Session of the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick the following bills for enactment

(1) A Bill authorizing the City to grant certain concessions to the Pal-mer-McLellan Company, Limited, and to fix the valuation of the property of Frasers Limited in this City for taxation purposes.

(2) A Bill to authorize the issue of Debentures for the erection of a Fire Station, a Police Station, for Obstinate coughs and colds yield to the purchase of Queen's Park and for the further construction of Permanent Street Pavements, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000) (3) A Bill to provide for lighting by electricity the Fredericton and

St. Mary's Highway Bridge.


