FAVOR FEDERAL HIGHWAY FROM COAST TO COAST

Saskatoon, Sask., (July 16)—The feature of the municipalities convention this morning was an address by ex-Mayor W. Sanford Evans, of Winnipeg, upon municipal financing, in which he advocated the establishment of a local government board which shall fulfill the same capacity as the local government boards of Great Britain, so that before municipal debentures can be floated on the world's money market, the official approval of the board would be given for proposed expenditures under such loan. A general discussion followed.

Alderman May, of Edmonton, presented a radical resolution which after reciting how the increase of urban land values directly followed heavy expenditures in municipal improvements, went on to advocate a real estate increment tax for benefit of the municipality. This provoked considerable discussion, and eventually the debate was adjourned until tomorrow.

An important resolution was adopted on motion of Commissioner Neill, of North Battleford, calling on federal and provincial governments to pass legislation protecting the credit of municipalities from misleading or slanderous attacks in the press or otherwise, and providing that where attacks are made on the credit of a municipality, these must be specific and over the signature of their authors.

Controller Church, of Toronto, in offering a resolution in favor of the inter-provincial highway, said that what was wanted was to get the federal government to spend \$25,000,000 on highways, throughout the Dominion, building an inter-provincial highways.

Some western delegates thought that railroads were of more use to the farmer than an inter-provincial highway, which catered mainly to the touring automobiles. The discussion was proceeding at adjournment for luncheon.

All this afternoon's session, Controller Church of Toronto, in discussing inter-provincial highways, said Canada was lurking behind on the good roads and highways question. A good road was wanted from coast

TOOK PRECAUTIONS AGAINST DIVORCE

Canton, O., July 19—The holy bond of matrimony will not be the only bond that joins Miss Elizabeth Beldi, of Canton, and Casian Bartt, Jr., of Youngstown, when they are wed tomorrow. To insure of the wedded bliss of the young couple an iron-clad agreement, backed by bonds pledging a \$700 farm and \$700 cash, has been put up by the fathers of the prospective bride and bridegroom. The young people themselves have no doubt that their marriage will prove a happy one. They have sworn eternal love to one another and declare that the agreement and bonds are entirely superfluous, but the old folk, noting the increase of the divorce evil, decided to do all they can in a legal way to make the marriage stick so tight that it can never become unknotted. By the terms of agreement the bridegroom's father promises that his son will never loaf, gamble, drink, play pool or dance with any young woman other than his wife. The bride's father, on the other hand promises that his daughter will make a model wife, will not gossip, run around with other men and will cook to the husband's satisfaction. A forfeiture of the \$700 bond is to follow a violation of the promises made by either side.

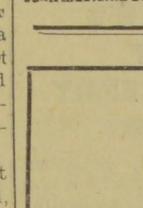
to coast and better roads in all parts of the province. The inter-provincial highway should, he declared, be built with a view to the future, and should have a permanent basis. The federal government should build the trunk lines and the provinces and municipalities the local and lateral lines.

Hon. Mr. Stewart, minister of education for Alberta, followed with a brief speech touching upon the question of civic government in that province.

Mayor Oliver, of Port Arthur, then introduced his resolution to the effect that the union request the various provincial governments to take up the idea of a great provincial highway, and the federal government be urged to assist the system by means of liberal subsidies. The motion was enthusiastically endorsed.

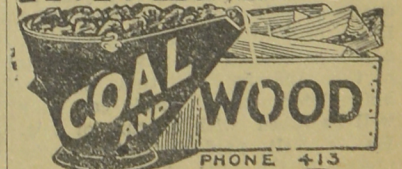
