

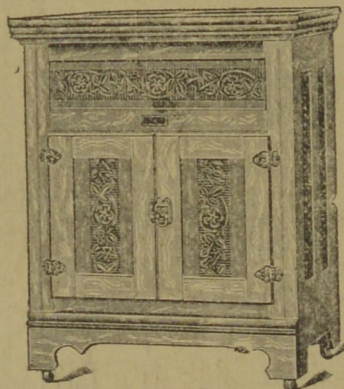
Fredericton, N. B., July 19, 1913
