



MINISTERS TO LOSE MARRIAGE FEES

Winnsor, Ont., April 10-Alarmed t the prospect of the new Marriage Bill passing the Legislature and imposing a residence that will wipe out Windsor's Gretna Green, The Rev. W. E. Prescott, pastor of Bathurst Street Church, Toronto, informed Mr J. Clinton, recording steward that without fees for performing man riages he did not feel inclined to come to Windsor at the salary \$1,600 agreed upon at the time of accepting the call to succeed the Rev W.
