## LIBERALS AT OTTAWA

and any other public measure which the government had submitted to the house were proceeded with.

Speaker Sproule called Mr. MacKenzie's attention to "the fact that the hon. member is not keeping to the discussion of the resolution now before the house." He ought to remember that there was a resolution before the house and to discuss the merits or demerits of the constitutionally of any other measure seemed entirely out of order.

Mr. MacKenzie said he must bow to the speaker's ruling, but submitted that there must be grave reason for the gag resolution before the house before the government was authorized to pass it. He was seeking to show that no such condition existed. "If I can show there is no reason for introducing the resolution, I am within my rights," he maintained.

Mr. German followed in a speech pulsating with indignation. He declared that the procedure of the premier and his government in preventing Sir Wilfrid Laurier from speaking was "the most disgraceful thing that had ever happened in Canadian parliamentary history." It manifested neither the manliness of a statesman or the courage of a brave man. The only proper course was to have followed all precedent Canadian or British and have referred any proposed amendment of the rules to a committee with the speaker to thresh them out in an amicable discussion.

Of the Borden resolution Mr. German said it was conceived in iniquity and born in sin. It was "unrighteous and villainous and was designed to destroy the fundamental principle of parliamentary control of the public purse." He said its presentation "was absolutely hypocritical" the worst of steam roller methods had been followed. Mr. Borden said that the government had first attempted "physical force" but the yellow thread in the woof of its constitution became manifest. They got scared, as the boys would say, and now they seek to do it by subversion of the fundamental principles of self government.

"What will the Government do?" asked Mr. German. "It will force this bill through the house of commons, but s.r. this house of commons does not hold all the Liberals who occupy positions in the parliament of Canada. And sir, I greatly misjudge the strength of the Liberals who at the present time dominate the upper house of parliament. If the strength of those Liberals is not sufficient to destroy this bill, as it should be destroyed, I say that my honorable friend will be up against a stiff proposition. I hope he will, I believe he will, because Liberals in this country do not intend to lie down under this kind of 'gag rule and steam-roller politics, but whatever constitutional or legal means we have to defeat this bill and the principles embodied in this bill the Liberals in Canada propose to take, and to take responsibility for." (Liberals cheering)

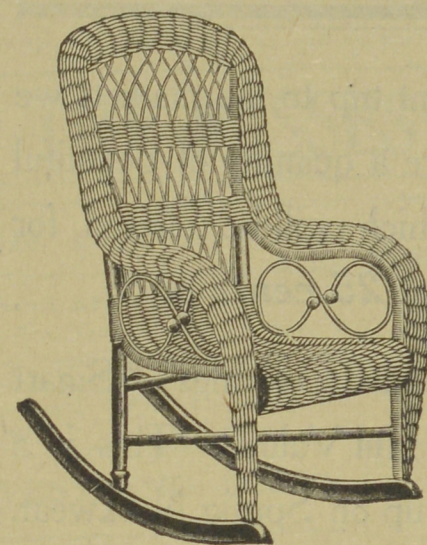
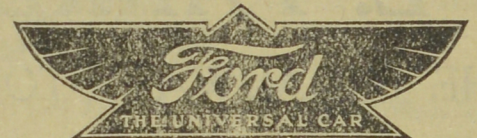
