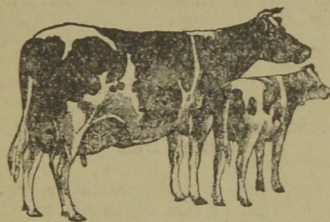

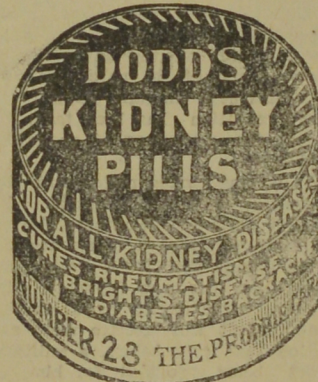
An epidemic of La Grippe has been quite prevalent in this community of late. All are convalescent.

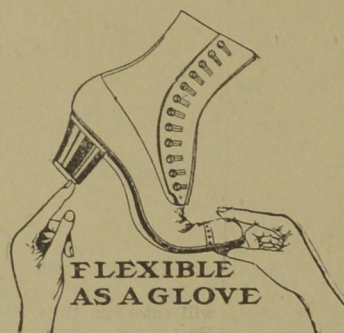
