### OUTWITS DIVORCED

Fryer, a wealthy retired merchant of Jersey City, has got from his divorced wife, by stratagem, the posession of the five younger children of the couple, and is now half way across the continent with them, bound for California.

Though Mr. Fryer started on his long journey Friday night, it was not until yesterday that the news of his movements and a clue to the whereabouts of the children became publicly known in Jersey City.
