THE FINANCIAL TIMES BOOSTS FREDERICTON

Says This City Has Advantages Not Generally Known Outside---City Located in the Centre of a Rich Agricultural District

Fredricton, N. B.—Fredricton, not inaptly termed "the celestial city," is in common with other sections of New Brunswick, enjoying an era of unparalleled prosperity. New Brunswick is destined in the very near future to become one of the most enterprising and prosperous of the provinces of the Dominion. In Fredricton, the capital of New Brunswick, a new spirit of optimism pervades. With the extensive railroad and industrial development, together with the bustling thoroughfares of the city, Fredricton certainly has thrown off the lethargy, which seems to have been so characteristic of most parts of the maritime provinces, despite the infinite variety of their natural resources, their equitable climate, their proximity to the mother country and their many other manifest advantages.

WHERE FREDERICTON IS LOCATED

Fredricton is situated practically midway of the famous Saint John River Valley in New Brunswick. It is 66 miles from the port of St. John, Fredricton, and is admirably located from the standpoint of Trans-Atlantic shipments, while the markets of the maritime provinces and in fact the whole of the Dominion of Canada can be very conveniently

reached. Adequate transportation facilities enhance its advantages as a manufacturing centre. Both the Canadian Pacific and the Intercolonial Railways serve the city at the present time, and manufacturers here are enabled to secure a freight rate to western Canada that is practically the same as that from the larger eastern centres of the Dominion. The St. John Valley and the Fredricton and Grand Lake Railways are in course of construction, while the Grand Trunk Pacific will be completed to Fredricton within the very near future, giving this city five large railways in addition to the service by the river steamers on the Saint John River.

CHEAP ELECTRIC POWER

The cheapest of electric power is available in Fredricton, while three companies of recognized stability have been formed to develop the natural powers of the St. John River and to provide Fredricton manufacturers with cheap water power. Through the construction of the Fredricton and Grand Lake Railway Fredricton manufacturers will receive the advantage of the Grand Lake coal at a low figure, which will undoubtedly serve to materially reduce the cost of power. There is a large supply of available help, which owing to the city's desirable location can be secured without encountering any difficulty.

FRUIT, TIMBER AND AGRICULTURAL RESOURCES

While the resources of the district surrounding Fredricton are many and varied, perhaps the greatest wealth of this district is in timber and agriculture. Within very easy reach of Fredricton are areas of hard and soft wood of almost inexhaustible extent, including spruce, pine, hemlock, maple, birch and beech; which can be assembled here to excellent advantage.

Agricultural and fruit-growing lands the equal of any in the Dominion of Canada, lie in the immediate vicinity of Fredricton and may be acquired at prices that are very reasonable.

FLOURISHING INDUSTRIES

Fredricton possesses several large and flourishing industries that are leaders in their respective lines for business of the markets of Canada. During the past year three large factories were erected in Fredricton.

Not only as an industrial centre, however, is Fredricton prominent, as there are located the Provincial Educational Institutions, which rank with the best on the continent. The parliament and Departmental Buildings are striking structures, while the churches, notably the Anglican Cathedral, are imposing and beautiful edifices.

OPENINGS FOR MANUFACTURERS

There are a great many openings for manufacturing plants in Fredricton, and the city council has the authority to assist bona fide propositions to the extent of free site, free water and exemption from taxation for a definite period of years. The tremendous timber resources in this district make the opening particularly

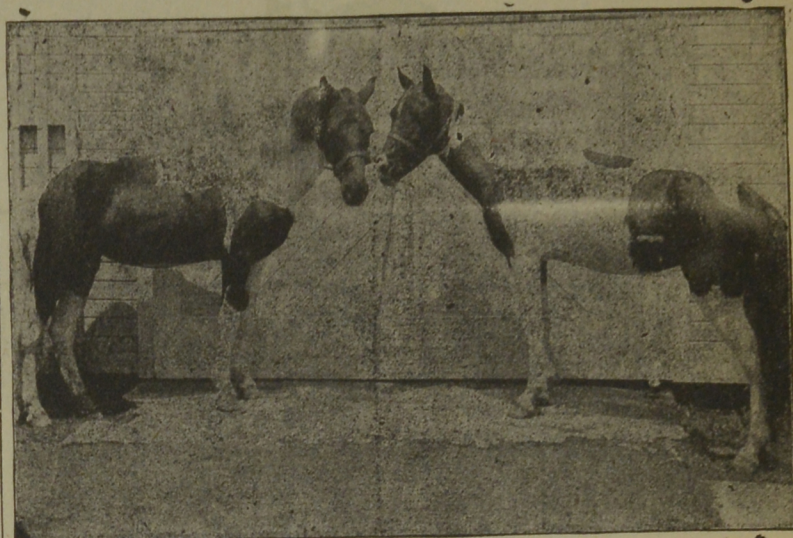

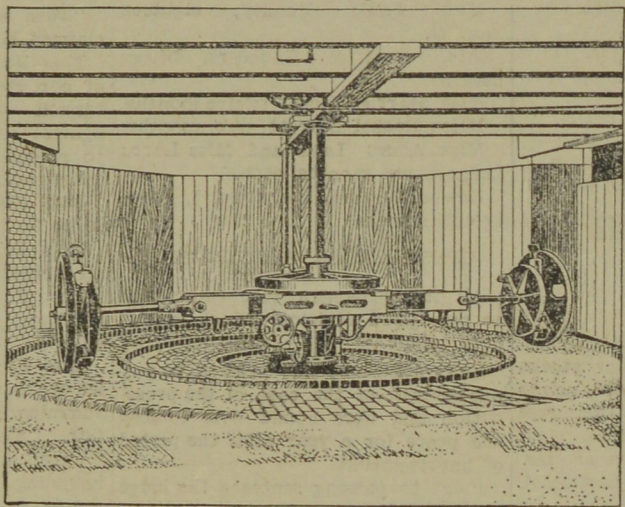

The "Paving Determinator's" Verdict.

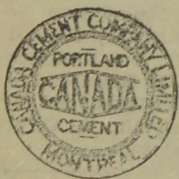
THE "Paving Determinator" is an ingenious machine that was built by the department of Public Works of Detroit—to subject sample stretches of various street pavements to severe, actual-service tests. It imitates heavy trucks and steel-shod draught horses, reproducing, in faithful detail, every effect of this kind of traffic. This remarkable machine was recently used to test five varieties of street pavement—covering practically the entire range of present-day road coverings.

A report of the test says:

"When the test had been made under the direction of Mr. McCabe and officials of the department, on eight sections of pavement laid in a circular track, the concrete section, laid under the specifications of the Board of County Road Commissioners of Wayne County, Michigan, showed by far the best resistance to the severe test to which the pavements were put."
