




Any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old may homestead a quarter-section available Dominion land in Manitoba Saskatchewan or Alberta. The appli cant must appear in person at the Do-minion Lanus Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain condi-tions, by father, mocher, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending home-steader. steader. Duties--Six months residence

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a
