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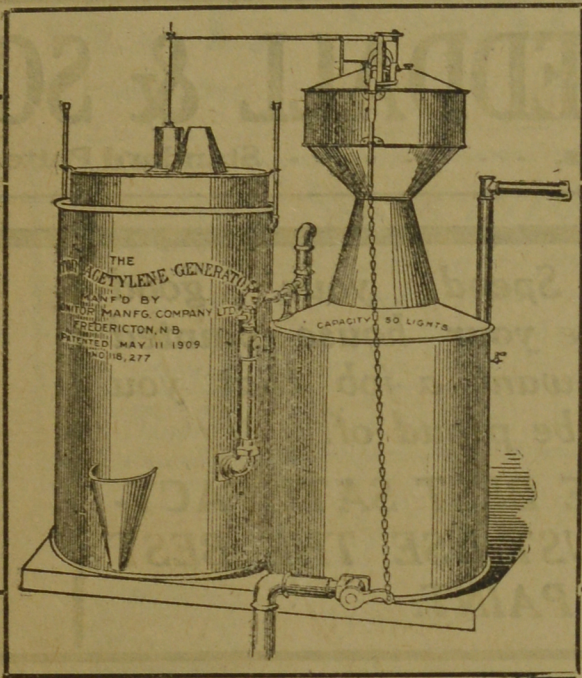

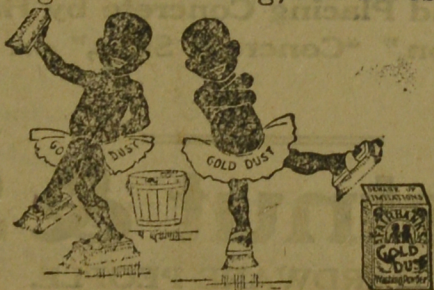

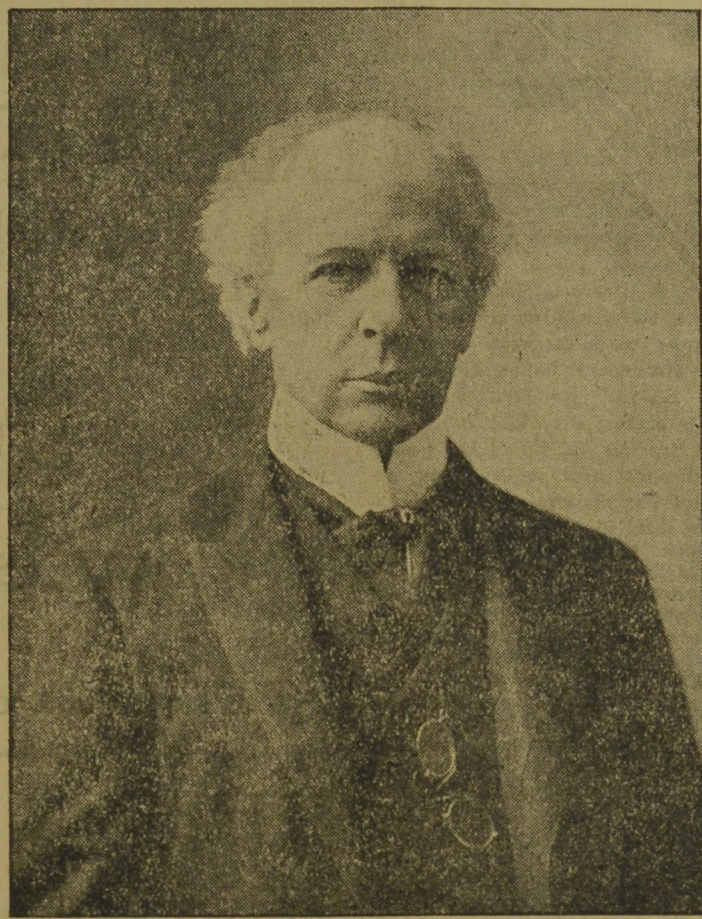

SIR WILFRID LAURIER TO TOUR THE WEST



Ottawa, May 17—Sir Wilfrid Laurier's political tour of western Canada will begin during the first week in July and will last sixty days during which the premier will visit all the important centres in the west, from Port Arthur to Prince Rupert.

The exact itinerary has not yet been arranged for the dates, but it is settled that Sir Wilfrid, accompanied by Hon. Geo. P. Graham, E. M. MacDonald, M.P., and F. F. Pardee M. P., chief Liberal whip, will leave Ottawa July 7 or 8 speaking the following day at Port Arthur or Fort William.

A couple of days or so will be spent in Winnipeg, and during the following three weeks meetings will be

held at various points in the prairie provinces, including, Brandon, Moose jaw, Saskatoon, Yorkton, Regina, Calgary, Edmonton, Medicine Hat, Lethbridge and other points in Alberta. Vancouver will be reached early in August and a couple of days will be spent there and in Victoria. The party will go as far north as Prince Rupert.

Sir Wilfrid will be back in the capital by Sept. 6 or 7.

Hon. Mr. Fielding will be unable to accompany the premier, as he will be absent in England during July.

Sir Wilfrid will go to Quebec tomorrow for a few days and during next month he will take a short holiday at his old home in Arthabaska-ville.

DR. TORREY CONTINUES TO ATTRACT GREAT AUDIENCES

Yesterday's Meetings Well Attended—Most Forceful Sermon Preached At Arctic Rink Last Night—Evangelist Continued Sermons on Bible.

The big evangelistic campaign is well under way. Yesterday was a most successful day. The meetings in the Methodist Church in the afternoon are growing in popularity and power. Those who attend one of them must have some compelling cause to stay away. Together with the morning neighborhood prayer meetings, the afternoon service is the power house of inspiration and the school house of instruction for the campaign.

The conditions for successful meetings are becoming more favorable at the rink. The warmth of the day affected a marked change in the temperature and the disturbance in the bowling alley has become a thing of the past.

Mr. Butler's handling of his choir and also his solo singing are engendering just enthusiasm. Dr. Torrey spoke of him last night as the leading gospel singer of the world. "Alexander can lead a chorus as well, but he cannot sing as well."

Mr. McConnell had a good word to say for the press. He encouraged people to send the daily papers containing reports of Dr. Torrey's sermons to their friends.

Dr. Torrey in his sermon gave five more reasons why he believed the Bible to be the Word of God; and it is not surprising that one of the "greatest sermon ever preached" Texarkana papers characterized it as in our city.

"I believe the Bible to be the Word of God, because of the character of those who accept it as such, and because of the character of those who reject it. Two things speak for the Divine origin of this Book—the character of those who are sure that it is the

WORD OF GOD

and the character of those who deny it. Oftentimes when some man or woman says to me, "I believe firmly the Bible to be the Word of God," and when I look at the purity, the beauty, the humanity, the devotion to God and man that there is in their character, how near they live to God, I feel like saying, "I am glad that you do believe the Bible to be the Word of God. The fact that one who

LIVES SO NEAR GOD

and knows God as well as you do, believes the Bible to be His Book, is a confirmation of my own faith that it is." On the other hand, oftentimes when men with a self-confident toss of the head say, "I do not believe the Bible is the Word of God," and when I look at the sinfulness or selfishness or smallness or sordidness of their lives, how far they live from God, I feel like saying, "I am glad that you do not. The fact that a man who is living upon the plane that you are living, living so far from God, and

KNOWS GOD SO LITTLE

doubts that the Bible is the Word of God, is a confirmation of my own faith that it is." Do not misunderstand me. I do not mean by this that every man who professes to believe in the Bible is better than every man who rejects the Bible; but what I do mean is this, show me a man who is living a life of absolute surrender to God, living under the control of the Spirit of God, living a life of devotion to the highest welfare of his fellowmen, a life of humility and of prayer, and I will show you every time a man who believes the Bible to be God's Word.

Show me the man who denies or persistently questions whether the Bible is the Word of God, and I will show you a man that is leading either (mind you, I say "either," not "all") a life of greed for gold, or of lust, or of self-will, or of spiritual pride. I challenge any man to furnish me an exception.

I have been looking for one literally around the world, and I have never found one. An attempt to furnish an exception has been made a number of times, but it is simply laughable to think of the men suggested as leading lives of "humility and prayer" or to think of them as not leading lives of "self-will." Anyone who has not surrendered absolutely to God is leading a

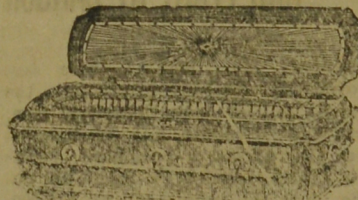

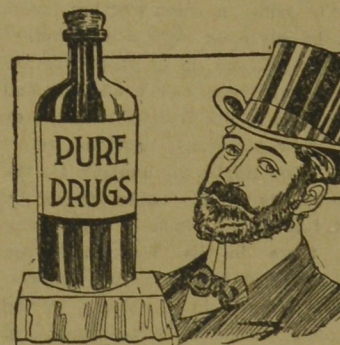
