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

## Is Good?

Examine closely this map, note that Railway "MAIN" Street intersects Vernon Park. The property values on this street range in price from \$75 to \$250 per frontage foot. Property along Ninth Avenue, North, adjoining the school, is marketable from \$150 to \$300 per lot.

Claresholm's water supply is of the best and the system was installed at a cost of \$75,000 in 1909, bringing the water into town six miles from the west.

The Electric Lighting Plant, "municipal," was also constructed in 1909 at a cost of \$30,000.

An extension of \$20,000 was added to the Public School in 1909. The original school was built in 1907, but owing to the rapid growth in population, this addition was demanded, making the total cost \$45,000, the best in Southern Alberta.

These large expenditures go to show the confidence the citizens of this prosperous town have for the future, and have laid the foundation for what will shortly be termed the CITY OF CLARES-HOLM.
