The rebels who occupy Wu Chang Honkow and Han Yang, were alive to the government's purpose and during last night, 2,000 men crossed the Yang Tse Kiang River from Wu Chang and at daybreak they fell up on the imperial camp. They attack ed with dash and the government troops taken somewhat at a disad vantage, responded loyally. The fighting was severe, but it is impossible to describe the casualties as the correspondents were not permitted near the firing line, and those who witnessed the battle from the river, were fired upon.
