SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH- WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY PERSON who is the sole head
of a family, or any male over eigh-
teen years old, may homestead a
quarter section of available Domin-
ion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan
or Alberta. The applicant must ap-
pear in person at the Dominion Land
Agency for the district. Entry by
proxy may be made at any agency,
on certain conditions, by father,
mother, son, daughter, brother or
sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months' residence upon
and cultivation of the land in each
of three years. A homesteader may
live within nine miles of his home-
stead on a farm of at least eighty
acres, solely owned and occupied by
him or by his father, mother, son,
daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader
in good standing may pre-empt a
quarter section alongside his home-
stead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties
—Must reside upon the homestead or
(including the time required to earn
homestead patent) and cultivate fifty
acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted
his homestead right and cannot ob-
tain a pre-emption, may enter for a
purchased homestead in certain dis-
tricts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties,
—Must reside six months in each of
three years, cultivate 40 acres and
erect a house worth \$300.00.

booth at the Domestic Science and
Pure Food Exhibition, which opened
in Madison Square Garden this after-
noon and will continue until October
4. The proceeds derived from the suf-
frage exhibit will go toward a \$100,-
000 fund that is being raised for
political work.
