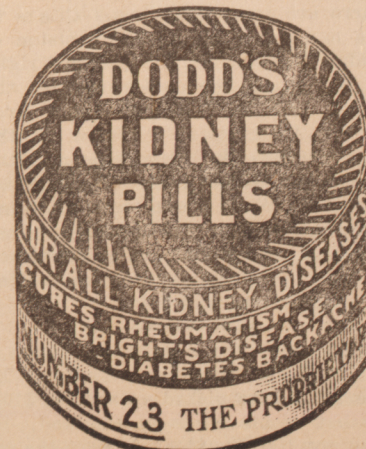
HAREM SKIRTS MAKE
