in India and that further generou gifts would be made for the same urpose. He also announced that half months pay would be granted to the non-commissioned officers and the men as well as the rest of the British army in India, and that officers and men of the native army in India would be eligible hereafter to be awarded the Victoria Cross for bray ery on the battle-field

A half month's pay was also grant ed to subordinate civil servants and certain classes of prisoners were released from jail. Another important change announced by Lord Harding was that the seat af government was in future to be transferred from Calcutta to Delhi. The greatest of Durbars ever held in India then came to an end, with the National Anthem, and a final burst from the silver trumpets. As the King-Emperor and Queen Empress accompanied by Lord and Lady Harding and their suites left the amphitheatre, they were cheered time and again by the crowd until they reached their tents.
