

22. Those tracts of land granted the said Alexander Gibson by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick No. 11,470, to date the seventeenth day of September A. D. 1866, and therein described as being a pole which is distant on a course by the magnetic needle of about eight hundred and sixty five South seventy two degrees East on a plain from a marked Birch tree standing on the southeastern angle of Lot first purchased by Alexander Gibson near the Nashwak River above the Sister Brooks; thence running North eighty five degrees East for the distance of five chains and fifty links, thence South
