POPE'S ALLOCUTION.

The Pope, following the ceremony, delivered a brief allocution, beginning by saying that the present year is a year of mourning for the church All felt that this phrase alluded to Italian jubilee, which, it is felt, offended the rights of the Holy See, through the manii?stations of sectarians, evidently hinting at the Free Masons' hatred to the Catholic faith, the allocution continues, was pro the whole world, while the supreme greatness of Italy is this faith which has inspired every civil progress and which alone is the source of peace and lasting prosperity.
