On examining the above statement the balance on hand in the Permantent Street Account is \$4,245.41, about sufficient to complete two more short blocks of pavement, which amount is not sufficient for the present needs of the application of the Tarvia and the application of these is quite within reason, but the fact that the haul was much shorter this year than last year should have materially lessened the cost of teaming, rather than have increased, it.

The cost of the binder and the labor incidental to the application of the Tarvia and the present needs of the city. 
