ANY PERSON who is the sole head of a family, or any male over eigh teen years old, may homstead s quarter section of available Dominon land in Manitoba, Saskatchewar or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother sister of intending homesteader. mother, son, daughter, brother or

Duties-Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each Middlehaddam, Conn. Sept 19- of three years. A homesteader mas

In certain districts a homesteader quarter section alongside his home he also stead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties -Must reside upon the homestead or (including the time required to earn nomestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot ob tain a pre-emption, may enter for a purchased homestead in certain dis tricts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties -Must reside six months in each of hree vears, cultivate fifty acres an erect a house worth \$300.00. W. W. CORY,
