

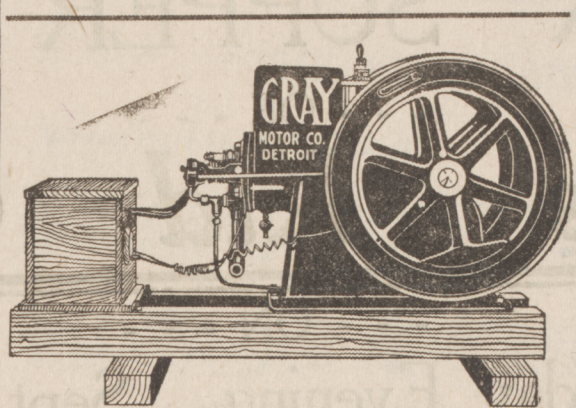

TORIES ALWAYS FAVORED RECIPROCITY

(Continued from page two.)

reciprocity to engage in business with us and then suddenly cut us off. I have taken the trouble, to look into the customers with whom the United States does business. It may interest you all to know that of all the countries with which the United States TRADES CANADA IS BY VERY LONG ODDS THE BEST CUSTOMER. IT IS NOT A CASE OF CANADA FIRST AND THE REST SOMEWHERE; IT IS CANADA FIRST AND THE REST NOWHERE. Sir in the last year, 1910, I find that imports by Canada per capita from the United States were \$29, that the total imports of Canada from the United States were very considerably greater than the imports of Mexico and South America combined, although they contained 62,000,000 people as against our 7,500,000.

WILL LOOK AFTER BEST
CUSTOMER.

"There are two deductions from that," Sir Richard continued. "One is this: THE TRADE OF THE UNITED STATES WITH GREAT BRITAIN AND WITH CANADA IS GREATER THAN HER TRADE WITH ALL THE REST OF THE WORLD PUT TOGETHER. I need not tell you it is to the interests of the United States to look after her best customers, and it is perfectly clear that if Canada goes on increasing her trade with the United States at the same ratio for a few

years she will become not only relatively her best customer, but by FAR HER BEST CUSTOMER, LEADING EVEN GREAT BRITAIN. THIS WILL BE WITHIN THE NEXT FIVE OR TEN YEARS, PROVIDING THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT CONTINUES IN POWER." (Laughter and applause.)

The opposition advised that the government should spurn the overtures of the United States. Such an act would make them the lineal descendants of the miserable men who undid the work of the great Pitt.

WHAT RECIPROCITY MEANS.

"IF YOU DESIRE TO HAVE PROSPERITY GRANTED IN SOME REASONABLE DEGREE TO THOSE PORTIONS OF OUR DOMINION WHICH HAVE NOT PROSPERED AS THE REST OF US HAVE, THEN PASS THIS AGREEMENT," continued Sir Richard. "If you desire to see the balance of trade restored, then pass this agreement. If you desire to render great service to the British Empire to which you belong, greater than presenting twenty Dreadnoughts or a thousand volunteers, then vote for this agreement, because anything which promotes good-will between Great Britain and the United States is in the highest degree for the benefit of the British Empire.

"Now, my friends," he said in closing, "the time has come for Can-

ada to assert herself. We made one great step when we passed the British preference. This will be another great step in the right direction." "So long as Canada remains a part of the British Empire, Canada's position geographically is such that she must be either a hostage or a link of union between Great Britain and the United States. I speak as great statesman on either side would speak were they here, as Grey or Asquith or Balfour would speak, when I tell you that as matters now stand in Europe the man of English birth and English lineage who endeavors to sow the seeds of discord or promote ill-feeling between England and the United States is of all living men the worst traitor to the British Empire and to the Dominion of Canada."

When Sir Richard concluded there was a great outburst of cheering, the audience rising in a body and giving vent to their enthusiasm.

GAUTIER CENTENARY KEPT

Paris, Aug. 31.—The one hundredth anniversary of the birth of the celebrated poet and novelist, Theophile Gautier, was observed in Paris and generally throughout France today. There were anniversary exercises under the auspices of various literary societies, and in Paris a memorial edition of the author's works was brought out. Gautier was born in the south of France August 31, 1811, but passed the greater part of his life in Paris. He died in this city December 23, 1872.

DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVAL SERVICE

A competitive examination will be held in November next at the examination centres of the Civil Service Commission for the entry of Naval Cadets for the Naval Service of Canada; there will be 25 vacancies.

Candidates must be between the ages of 14 and 16 years on the 1st of January next; must be British subjects and must have resided in Canada for two years immediately preceding the examination; short periods of absence abroad for purpose of education to be considered as residence. Successful candidates will join the Royal Naval College at Halifax, in January next; the course at the College is two years and the cost to parents, including board, lodging, uniform and all expenses is approximately \$400 for the first year and \$250 for the second year.

On passing out of College, Cadets will be rated midshipmen, and will receive pay at the rate of \$2 per diem. Parents of intending candidates should make application to the Secretary Civil Service Commission, Ottawa, before the 15th October next.

Further information can be obtained on application to the Secretary, Department of Naval Service, Ottawa.

UNDER TORY RULE.

"Under the Conservative regime people were flying from Canada as from a plague-stricken country. That 1891 census—and he reiterated the gravest doubts that the records were truly kept—showed an increase of only 30 souls in New Brunswick, and of but 1-5 of 1 per cent. in Nova Scotia. Canadian Pacific was worth fifty cents in the dollar in 1896, and the value of the whole common stock issue was but \$32,000,000; today it was valued at \$425,000,000.—Sir Richard Cartwright at Toronto.

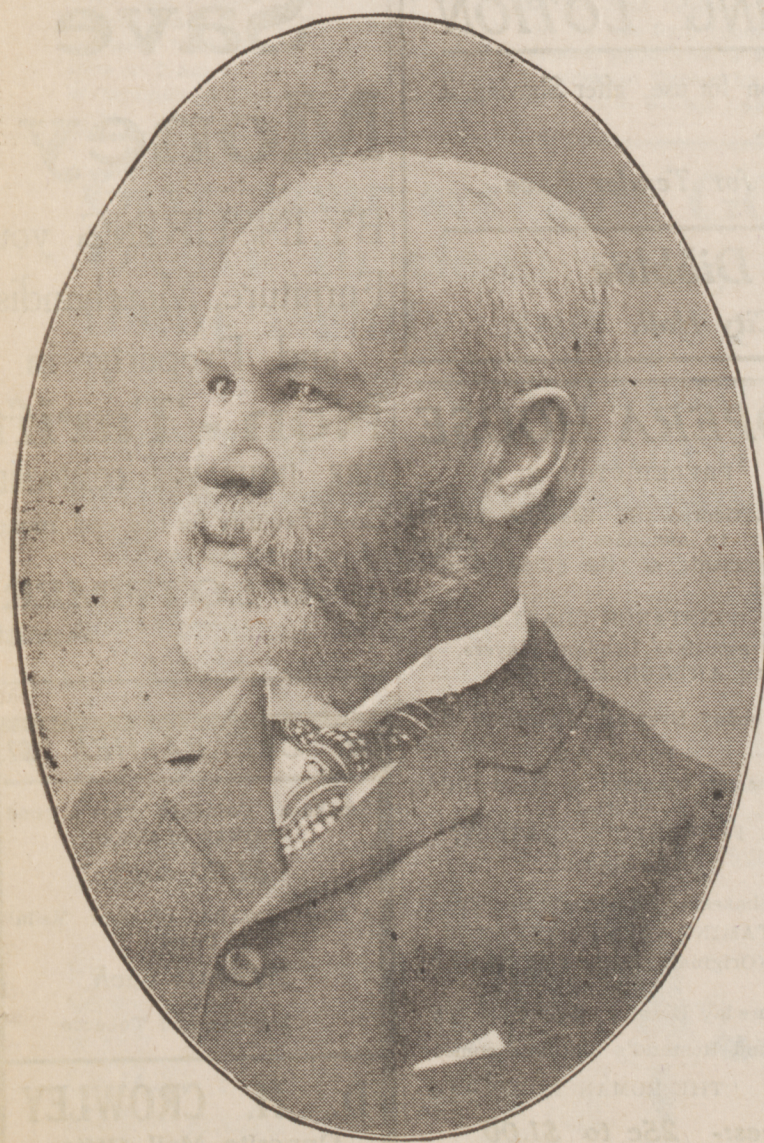
