BIG DIFFERENCE.

The United States Steel Corporation gets \$28 for rails in the States, and has been selling them abroad at \$20.

It is a recognized business custom for large concerns to export a surplus at a loss in order to keep production up to the maximum, and thus reduce operating costs, but \$5 a ton difference is too much of a good thing. The Stanley committee, which is investigating the Trust, will no doubt make a telling point against it on this discrimination against the home market.

SOVEREIGN BANK.

The estimate by "a banking authority" that the shareholders of the Sovereign Bank will not lose a dollar is pretty optimistic.

SAME HARRIMAN DIVIDENDS.
 Regular dividends on Union and Southern Pacific were declared today. They are payable January 2nd, to holders of December 1st.

STOCK FELL FROM 91 TO 70.
 London, Nov. 9.—The dramatic fall

in the shares of the Dominion Sawmills & Lumber Co., which dropped in one month from 91 to 70, and then to 60, have led to demands for an official statement in the interests of the debenture holders.

Lord Desborough, chairman of the company, is expected next week from Canada, where he went with the Duke of Sutherland in August.

The Canadian Board consists of Mr. Elihu Stewart, late superintendent of forestry at Ottawa; Mr. Alexander McRae of Revelstoke, and Mr. W. E. Hodges of Vancouver, while Mr. S. A. Mundy of Three Valley, B.C., is president and managing director.

The Financial Times repeats the market rumors of grave misconduct on the part of some official; also that while the company has cut a large quantity of timber, it has been unable to market it successfully owing to severe American competition.

The company offered £300,000 6 p.c. first mortgage debentures here in June, 1910; also offered in June, 1911 \$5,000,000 participating cumulative 7 p.c. preference shares at par.

The Canadian Gazette says the expenses incidental to this issue were enormous, the company having to pay 12½ per cent. on a considerable portion.
