WANTS TO DEFEND  
BIG SCOUNDRELS

Rome, July 31—After a long and heated discussion, by five votes to four and one abstention, the Rome Council of Lawyers has admitted Signorina Theresa Labriola to the profession. The Supreme Court has the power to revoke the decision, as was done in the case of a former feminine aspirant to the bar, but public opinion has changed and there is every probability that Signorina Labriola will go down to posterity as the first woman lawyer in Italy. She has doubly won her right to admission, having gained the laureate of Doctor of Law at the Rome University and having passed every examination required of men outside of university honors.

"I feel very proud of my success," said the Signorina to The World correspondent. "Of course there is a chance that the higher court will reverse the Council's decision but I am hopeful that I shall escape this disappointment."

"What branch of the law do I intend to take up? Well, I have a great fancy to defend every big scoundrel who may come to me for advice. I shall throw myself heart and soul into every case where the proverbial woman is at the bottom of it."

"And I hope that after paying the way for the admission of women to practice I shall have a long roll of colleagues behind me before many years. I think the law offers a far better opening to a woman than teaching for it does not interfere with her duties as a wife and mother. You are far ahead of us in America on the question of admitting my sex to the liberal professions but I look upon this as a great victory for our cause."

Signorina Labriola is a charming brunette of apparently twenty-five summers. She belongs to a Roman family long noted for the number of its members distinguished in science and literature.

## C.P.R. CRUISER FLEET IS BEING CONSIDERED

Montreal, July 30—Mr. Arthur Piers of the C.P.R. Steamship Lines is here for the purpose of consulting Sir Thomas Shaughnessy in regard to additions to the Atlantic fleet.

When Sir Thomas Shaughnessy was in London in the earlier part of this year tentative proposals for a cruiser fleet to be run by the C.P.R. were discussed with representatives of the British Government and the Hon. Mr. Hazen has admitted that the matter has since been a subject of negotiations between the British Admiralty and the representatives of the Canadian Government.

The idea is that with a sufficient subsidy there could be created a fleet for a splendid second line of defence for the Empire manned by a proportion of Royal Naval Reserve men, and with full equipment of guns and ammunition instantly available at the ports on either side of the ocean.

In peace time this fleet would be used for establishing a fast steamship line for the carrying of mails and passengers between Great Britain and Canada, thus not only keeping in excellent trim and condition but performing constant and valuable service to the Empire.

## CONFERENCE OF WESTERN GOVERNOR

Boise, Idaho, Aug. 1—The governors of many of the Western States are assembled here for the first annual meeting of the Association of Western Governors, which is the outgrowth of the Eastern tour taken by the governors last year. It is expected that by tomorrow practically all of the States embraced in the association will be represented.

The conference is to continue three days and will be devoted to the discussion of a wide range of subjects pertaining to the welfare and development of the West. The scheduled speakers and the subjects assigned them include the following: Governor Burke of North Dakota, "The Best Methods of Proclaiming a State's Resources," Governor West of Oregon, "The Employment and Reformation of Convicts," Governor Aldrich of Nebraska, "Taxation," Governor Hay of Washington, "State Supervision of Investments," Governor Shafroth of Colorado, "Conservation of Water Power," Governor Hawley of Idaho, "The Good Roads Factor in Western Development," Governor Carey of Wyoming, "The Reclamation of Arid Lands," and Governor Vessey of South Dakota, "Western Investments and Securities."
