Thus, according to the mechanica theory of heat, astrono ars who may live in the year 12000 of our era will b4 able to know what the sun's diameter has diminished about five miles since the beginning of telescopic ob servation.

In 7.000,000 years the sun will still radiate the same quantity of heat, but its disc will appear to man one-fouri's of its present size. From that moment nothing will be able to check the loss radiation. of the earth will show the effect. In our northern countries vegetation will ose a large part of its vitality.
