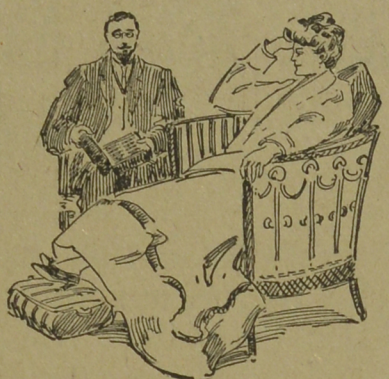

#### EFIOUS ACCIDENT ON S. S. D. J. PURDY

A serious accident took place at Indiantown this morning when the steamer D. J. Purdy was preparing to leave on her tri-weekly trip to Fredericton. Engineer McVicar and Fireman William Gordon, while oiling the machinery in connection with the paddle-wheels noticed that there was a log in the paddle box. As it was hard to get at they decided to try to throw it out by a turn of the paddles and the engineer went to start the machinery. Fireman Gordon remained at the box and while there received injuries that may have fatal result. It is stated that he leaned into the box too far when watching the log, and when the paddle-wheel started it struck him a terrific blow on the face, breaking his jaw and carrying him into the box and down into the water. A warning cry from a steamship official standing close by was sufficient to make the engineer realize that something had happened and he rushed out on deck. When he discovered that his companion had been knocked into the water he dove overboard, clothes and all, and coming catch hold of Gordon, who was sinking for the second time. Willing hands up under the wheel was in time to man to the wharf, while others sent a message to Dr. Case. The latter arrived shortly afterwards, and seeing that the young man was seriously injured ordered him sent to the hospital. Besides the broken jaw Mr. Gordon received a bad scalp wound and several other bruises. It is not known whether or not he received internal injuries.
