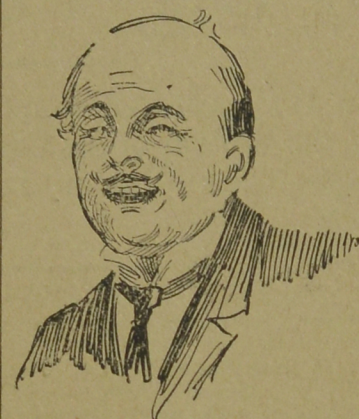

NINE PERSONS KILLED

Sioux Falls, S. D., June 24—Nine persons were killed and forty injured, some fatally and 300 buildings destroyed by a tornado which swept through Watertown, S. D., yesterday, according to information received here by telephone. The twister destroyed all communication by telegraph and telephone to the city direct, and information was meagre. The same despatch stated that the tornado did much other damage in the vicinity with probable loss of life.
