

#### FERTILIZED EGGS

Chief Cause of Inferior Stock For Food Purposes

Eggs which have been fertilized constitute the greatest proportion of the inferior stock which, when examin ed, proves unfit for food. It is not necessary that these shall have remained for a time under a broody hen, a temperature of seventy degrees being, in itself, sufficient to cause the germ to commence to grow. If the heat is constant the development of the chick will continue, but if it ceases or is intermittent, putrefaction at once sets in and the egg becomes bad. On the other hand infertile eggs cell, under ordinary conditions, de recommended in a circular issued by Department of Agricusture, to kill off or dispose of the male birds after the breeding season Canadian farmers lose each year at least a million dollars, through the presence of partially incubated eggs in the produce which is marketed. The fact that the best trade in many cities in Casada now offers the premium of from one to five cents per dozen, for nosfertilized eggs, suggests an additional financial consideration which but few can afford to overlook.

Quite a different and much more desirable rent is the one which has been charged to the tenant of Crendon, in Buckinghamshire, from time immemorial. The rent consists of a garland of roses every June, and, needless to say, the garland is duly forwarded, and is a thing of beauty, as it ought to be.

In September every year two faggots are paid at the Law Courts by the City Remembrancer as rent for lands held by the City Corporation from His Majesty the King. This official not only has to deliver the two faggots, but has to see that they are properly received and accept a duly signed and witnessed receipt for them, which is filed in the City's archives.

The authorities of the Isle of Portland make a queer sort of collection every November on behalf of His Majesty. It is called the "King' Halfpenny"; but, as a matter of fact every cottager on the island pays a farthing, every cottage with a gar den a halfpenny, and every man with an acre of land or more threepence This is called "quit rent."


