PROPER HANDLING OF FRESH EGGS

Consumers Should Demand Strictly

We have frequently had occasion to observe the detrimental influence of dirt and moisture on the keeping qualities of eggs, says a bulletin from Storrs Experimental Station. Of a large number of eggs which were stored in an ordinary refrigerator all were found, after three or four weeks, to be permeated with moulds. In other instances we have found bacteria, under similar conditions. In a crate filled with eggs which had been placed in a damp, dark basement, and which had remained there for several weeks, all of the eggs were in an advanced state of rotting when brought to light and examined. These eggs had come from the same hens the eggs of which as a rule, to be free from bacteria.

On the other hand, eggs which are incubated artificially remain undecomposed, with very few exceptions, for at least two or three weeks, and undoubtedly much longer, providing they are clean, fresh eggs when they are put into the incubator.

It is of the greatest importance that a general campaign be waged to secure eggs for consumption, and especially when they are to be preserved in cold storage, which are clean and perfectly fresh. The solution of this problem rests with both the producer and the buyer. The handling and keeping of eggs should also receive much consideration. It is necessary that the eggs be kept clean, dry and reasonably cool. They should be transported under the best conditions of sanitation, and when placed in cold storage the rooms in which they are kept should be dry.
