The weekly matinee races of the Fredericton Driving Club, which were postponed until Friday of this week, had to be again postponed yesterday on account of the cold weather.

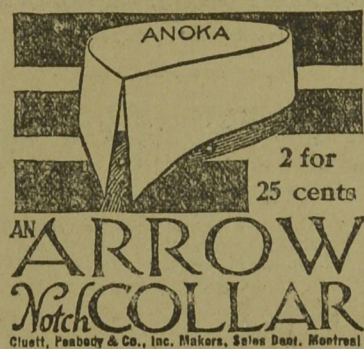
