Edmonton, May 4-"Unless such lands are redeemed on or before the 23 of May, 1914, the same will be absolutely forfeited for mon-payment of taxes.'

The absolute forfeiture of town lots or agricultural lands for the non payment of taxes is allowed to muni-cipalities under the Town Act 1912. 


